An ordinance establishing special funds and providing for an emergency.

THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDAINS:

SECTION I. SOLID WASTE FUND

A solid waste fund is hereby established for the purpose of implementing, operating and administrating the regional solid waste management program.

SECTION II. SOLID WASTE OBLIGATION #1 FUND

A solid waste obligation #1 fund is hereby established for the purpose of receiving state grants and loans for the design and construction of solid waste facilities.


SECTION III. JOHNSON CREEK DRAINAGE FUND


A Johnson Creek drainage fund is hereby established for the purpose of receiving funds for preparation of a drainage management plan for the Johnson Creek Drainage Basin, construction of flood control improvements and provision of annual administration, operation and maintenance for the Johnson Creek Drainage improvements.

SECTION IV. DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

To enable the board to make expenditures from the above special funds in accordance with state statutes, beginning July 1, 1974, the immediate passage of this ordinance is necessary, and an emergency is declared to exist. This ordinance takes effect upon passage.
