ORDINANCE NO. 21

THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDAINS:

SECTION I.


Subsection 10 of Section I of Ordinance No. 3, as amended by Ordinances No. 10 and 18, is amended to read:

"'Tire carrier' means any person engaged in picking up or transporting scrap tires for the purpose of disposal or salvage, whether or not incidental to some other business."


SECTION II.

In order to provide for the timely regulation of the removal of scrap tires from the Metropolitan Service District, an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance takes effect upon passage.
