THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDAINS THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION I.

Section 24 of Ordinance No. 32 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 24. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect (60 days subsequent to) upon the execution of a grant/loan or loan offer and acceptance with the Department of Environmental Quality for the State of Oregon for sufficient Pollution Control Bond funds (implementation of the construction phase of the Program) to purchase the real property known as the Rossman Processing Station Site.

SECTION II.

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 33 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect (60 days subsequent to) upon the execution of a grant/loan or loan offer and acceptance with the Department of Environmental Quality for the State of Oregon for sufficient Pollution Control Bond funds (implementation of the construction phase of the Program.) to purchase the real property known as the Rossman Processing Station Site.

SECTION III.

In order to take advantage of the recent release of Pollution Control Bond funds by the Emergency Board for the State of Oregon for the purchase of the Rossman Processing Station site and to take the first step toward implementation of the Program prior to termination of existing funding, it is necessary that this ordinance be enacted forthwith. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist.
