ORDINANCE 41

THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT HEREBY ORDAINS:

SECTION I.

For persons living within the boundaries of the Metropolitan Service District (MSD), the following schedule of fees shall be charged by the MSD for admittance to the Portland Zoological Gardens:

12 years and over	\$.75
6 years through 11 years	\$.25
Under 6 years	Free
Senior Citizens (65 years and over)	\$.25
Educational Groups	Free

SECTION II.

For persons living outside the boundaries of the MSD, the following schedule of fees shall be charged by the MSD for admittance to the Portland Zoological Gardens:

12 years and over	\$1.50
6 years through 11 years	\$.75
Under 6 years	Free
Senior Citizens (65 years and over)	\$.75
Educational Groups	\$.50 each

SECTION III.

The admission fees established by Sections I and II shall take effect Thursday, July 1, 1976.

SECTION IV.

As a result of voter approval of a 5-year, 10 million dollar tax levy, the MSD is assuming ownership and responsibility for the Zoo on July 1, 1976. In order to implement the admission fees on July 1, 1976, an emergency is hereby declared to exist.
