THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT ORDAINS THE FOLLOWING:

SECTION 1.

Section 24 of Ordinance No. 32 as amended by Ordinance No. 36 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 24. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect (upon the execution of a grant/loan or loan offer and acceptance with the Department of Environmental Quality for the State of Oregon for sufficient Pollution Control Bond funds to purchase the real property known as the Rossman Processing Station Site.) June 1, 1977.

SECTION 2.

Section 3 of Ordinance No. 33 as amended by Ordinance No. 36 is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Effective Date.

This ordinance shall take effect (upon the execution of a grant/loan or loan offer and acceptance with the Department of Environmental Quality for the State of Oregon for sufficient Pollution Control Bond funds to purchase the real property known as the Rossman Processing Station Site.) June 1, 1977.

SECTION 3.

The District and the DEQ will execute within the next three weeks a grant/loan agreement in an amount sufficient to trigger the present effective dates in Ordinances 32 and 33. The District, however, wants the effective date for these ordinances to be June 1, 1977. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist.
