# 1. DISCUSSION OF AGENDA FOR COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING, JUNE 29, 2006/ ADMINISTRATIVE/CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER AND CITIZEN COMMUNICATIONS

Mike Jordan, Chief Operating Officer, said that he had no communications at this time.

#### 2. GREENSPACES POLICY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (GPAC) UPDATE

Mike Ragsdale, GPAC Chair, gave an update on the Greenspaces Policy Advisory Committee (GPAC) and where they had reached in their efforts.

Chris Carlson, Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department, reviewed three (3) large maps displayed and also the smaller versions of those maps that had been handed out. There was discussion about the workshop that had been held regarding Greenspaces and the outcomes from that gathering. There was discussion about the farming community and how it would fit into the task of the committee.

Council President Bragdon said that they needed to be careful about how they categorized farmland. He said it was important to make a distinction between privately owned farms and public land.

Councilor Robert Liberty said that at least two of the Councilors were interested in long-term landscape. He said that there would be different functions for land both inside and outside the boundary, but that they could jointly determine how the future landscape would come together.

Rex Burkholder expressed interest in #5 of the GPAC Finance Report, Part 1 – Existing Financial Environment (Other/Miscellaneous Revenues), and having GPAC work on that in conjunction with transportation discussions. Ms. Carlson invited Councilor Burkholder and all the Councilors to the next meeting of GPAC in July.

Mike Ragsdale reviewed the handouts, GPAC Finance Report, Part 1 – Existing Financial Environment and, GPAC Finance Report, Part 2 – Potential New Funding Sources, for the Councilors. Those handouts are attached and form part of the record.

Mr. Ragsdale said that GPAC would like to come back to a Metro Council work session to give another update in about three (3) months.

Council President Bragdon reviewed what he anticipated the agenda for the New Look work session on the following day would entail.
