WHEREAS, the Metro Council adopted Resolution No. 00-2929A on August 10, 2000, which referred to the voters for their approval or disapproval, the question of amending the 1992 Metro Charter to abolish the Office of the Metro Executive Officer and changing the composition of the Metro Council to include a newly created position called Metro Council President; and

WHEREAS, Ballot Measure 26-10 was certified to be included and appear on the November 7, 2000 General Election Ballot; and

WHEREAS, a General Election was held in the State of Oregon on November 7, 2000; and


WHEREAS, ORS.255.295 requires that Metro shall determine the results of the General Election and notify the Multnomah County Elections Division of same; and

WHEREAS, the Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington County abstract of votes were received by the Metro Council as described in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the Metro Council hereby accepts the results of the November 7, 2000 General Election, approving Ballot Measure 26-10 amending the 1992 Metro Charter to abolish the Office of the Metro Executive Officer and changing the composition of the Metro Council to include a newly created position called Metro Council President; and
2. The voters of Metro have approved amending the Metro Charter as provided in Measure 26-10.

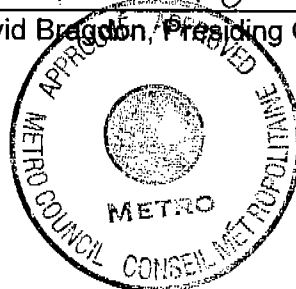

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 00-3021, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCEPTING THE NOVEMBER 7, 2000 GENERAL ELECTION ABSTRACT OF VOTES.

Proposed Action: Resolution 00-3021 accepts the results of the November 7, 2000 general election, with respect to Ballot Measure 26-10, and notifies the Multnomah elections division, as required by state law.

Factual Background and Analysis: The Metro Council adopted Resolution No. 00-2929A on August 10, 2000. This action resulted in submittal to the voters of Ballot Measure 26-10, abolishing the Office the Metro Executive Officer, creating a new council position of Council President, elected region-wide, and reducing council districts from 7 to 6. Ballot Measure 26-10 was approved by voters during the November 7, 2000 general election.

Applicable Law: ORS.255.295 requires that Metro shall determine the results of the General Election, based on the abstract of votes, and notify the Multnomah County Elections Division.

Budget Impact: There is no budget impact associated with the adoption of Resolution 00-3021.
