WHEREAS, VerioNW was selected as Metro Regional Services Internet service provider pursuant to a competitive process; and

WHEREAS, Metro Council and the Executive Officer desire to increase the amount of the VerioNW Personal Services Agreement to provide for Internet service provision to June 30, 2001; and

WHEREAS, Metro's Internet service provision contract will be re-bid in a competitive process in the spring of 2001; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED:

That the Metro Contract Review Board authorizes the Executive Officer to enter into Amendment No. 4 to the Personal Services Agreement with VerioNW Communications as shown in Exhibit A.

CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 00-2998 FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT NUMBER 4 OF THE PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH VerioNW, METRO CONTRACT 920624.

PROPOSED ACTION: Would amend the existing Personal Services Agreement with VerioNW for Internet service provision. The amendment would increase the contract by \$21,430.00, and the total contract amount would become \$72,569.00.

EXISTING LAW: Metro Code 2.04.046 requires Personal Services contract amendments over \$25,000 be approved by the Metro Contract Review Board.

BACKGROUND: Metro secured the services of VerioNW beginning July 1, 1998 for providing Metro access to the Internet via appropriate bandwidth to accommodate Metro's data transmission to/from Internet web sites. The current contract with VerioNW expires on November 23, 2000.

It is anticipated that proposals for Internet service provision will be solicited in the spring of 2001, with the intention that the successful proposer would begin on July 1, 2001.

BUDGET IMPACT: Resources are budgeted in the Information Technology Department through June 2001.

RECOMMENDED ACTION: The Executive Officer recommends approval of Resolution 00-xxxxx.

AMENDMENT NO. 4
PERSONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN METRO
AND VerioNW

This Amendment No. 4 to Personal Services Agreement (Agreement), hereby amends the above-titled Agreement between METRO, a metropolitan service district (METRO), and VerioNW, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

1. Contractor is presently performing and will continue to perform the services described in the original Agreement and Amendment Nos. 1, 2, and 3.
2. Metro and Contractor agree that the current Personal Service Agreement termination date shall be extended to June 30, 2001 at the current monthly rate of \$2,143.00.
3. This Agreement is a change order to the original Duration as follows:

Original termination date of November 23, 2000 shall be revised to read June 30, 2001. This change will increase the contract amount by \$21,420.00 for a total contract amount of \$72,569.00.

Except for the above, all other conditions and covenants remain in full force and effect.
