AMENDMENT TO THE CRAG LAND USE FRAMEWORK RULES SECTION 7 ADOPTED BY THE CRAG BOARD OF DIRECTORS JUNE 23, 1977 EFFECTIVE: JUNE 23, 1977

After the effective date of these rules, no member shall issue any building permit for construction of any new building of any type, or approve any subdivision plat, tentative subdivision plan or major or minor partition, in any area designated by the Framework Element as "Study Areas" unless and until such an area is subsequently redesignated as "Urban", "Rural" or "Natural Resource" by the Board of Directors or until the expiration of one (1) year from the effective date of these rules, whichever occurs first. This subsection shall apply only to the construction of new structures and not to additions, accessory uses or improvements to existing structures, and shall not apply to building permits for single family housing on lots approved or recorded prior to the effective date of of these rules. Further, this subsection shall not prevent or prohibit members from issuing building permits or approving public facilities and services which would otherwise be permissible if each Study Area were designated as a "Natural Resource" area. In addition, in those Study Areas entirely bounded by Rural or Urban designation on the Framework Map a member may issue a building permit or approve public facilities and services which would be permissible if such Study Area were designated as a "Rural" area.
