7. COUNCILOR COMMUNICATION

Councilor Burkholder reported on Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation (JPACT) meeting. They were looking at JPACT Bylaws changes and Regional Transportation Plan update. JPACT members also discussed the joint Metro Policy Advisory Committee/JPACT meeting on October 10th. He talked about the bylaws changes. He noted the split vote on the bylaws. There was a need for a 2/3rds majority to change the bylaws. Council President Bragdon asked why the bylaws were being changed? He understood that the federal government told Metro to do this. Councilor Burkholder said the federal government said they needed to considered changes. Councilor Newman said even if the bylaw changes went down you could still come back and change the technical areas in the bylaws. He felt most of the concerns centered on membership.

Councilor Liberty said he and Councilor Burkholder had the opportunity to watch the proceedings for Nancy Pelosy sponsored by Congressman Blumenhauer. Second, staff and he had just been discussing the local share and the neighborhood grant program. They were getting close to have a slate for the grant review committee.

Councilor Harrington said MPAC did not meet yesterday. She suggested a Council temporary assignment for JPACT. Council President Bragdon said they would discuss this at next Wednesday's Work Session. Councilor Harrington said she wanted to make sure if there was a vote that the Metro Council was represented.

Councilor Harrington said they represented citizens in the region. They had a regional economic development opportunity. City of Hillsboro made an investment in water supply. She said the Joint Water Commission and regional water partners would be making an appeal to Metro for a right away water project. They would be requesting one-on-one briefing sessions with Councilors. Councilor Liberty asked about the water supply and what the briefing was for. Councilor Harrington explained further the options available.

Council President Bragdon said the oversight committee for the bond measure met this morning. They were working on performance measures. Second, Metropolitan Exposition Recreation Commission (MERC) met yesterday and dealt with the headquarters hotel project. There was a fair amount of testimony. Most of the commissioners had been persuaded to support continuing to see if the project was viable. He then talked about the next steps for replacement of the District 2 vacancy. The deadline submission was October 18th. They would hold a hearing on October 25th on the issue. Councilor Newman announced that a reception would be held in his honor on September 27th after council meeting.

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There being no further business to come before the Metro Council, Council President Bragdon adjourned the meeting at 3:05 p.m.
