WHEREAS, expenditures and revenues have been appropriated in the Fiscal Year 2001-02 budget for this project, but it has not been included in the Fiscal Year 2001-02 Capital Improvement Plan; and

WHEREAS, the award of the capital grant and implementation of the project requires Metro to enter into an agreement with the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission;

WHEREAS, the implementation of this project will have a positive public benefit and increase citizen participation in Metro's government and decision-making processes;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Metro Council hereby authorizes the amendment of the FY 2001-02 Capital Improvement Plan to include the "Council Chamber Camera Project" in the amount of \$158,560, and further authorizes the Presiding Officer or his designee to enter into an agreement with Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission to award and implement a \$108,1000 capital grant.

IN CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 01-3107, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING THE FY 2001-02 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN TO INCLUDE THE COUNCIL CHAMBER CAMERA PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$158,560, AND AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDING OFFICER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MT. HOOD CABLE REGULATORY COMMISSION TO AWARD AND IMPLEMENT A \$108,100 CAPITAL GRANT.

BACKGROUND

In May 2001, Metro was awarded a Community Access Capital Grant from the Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission in the amount of \$108,100 to equip the Council Chamber for in-house video production and live cable casting. Because the grant came in after the formulation and approval of Metro's 2001-02 Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), the project is not included in the CIP. The recognition of the receipt of the grant, and the transfer and/or appropriation of funds required to complete the \$158,560 project were included in the adopted budget for Fiscal Year 2001-02, as follows:

In-kind technical contributions for system design, development, implementation, and in-house training will be provided by Multnomah County Television, Tualatin Valley Cable Access and Portland Community Access.

The proposed resolution approves the inclusion of the project in the CIP, and authorizes the Presiding Officer or his designee to enter into a contractual agreement with Mt. Hood Cable Regulatory Commission for the award and implementation of the capital grant.

Anticipated Effects This project would facilitate public involvement by increasing public access to Metro's decision-making process through more timely and predictable cablecasts of council proceedings to a wider geographic area, and through opportunities to participate interactively by phone, fax, or email, during live cablecasts.
- 4. **Budget Impacts** The total cost of the project is \$158,560, with \$117,550 deriving from the grant and in-kind contributions, and \$41,010 constituting Metro's matching share.
