Regarding: Itinerary for European Travel

As you are aware, the primary purpose of the trip will be to review development around transit stations and how that high density development has been managed in several European cities.

The arrangements for the trip to European cities have been finalized and following is the itinerary:

June 28)

Stockholm, Sweden

We arrive Saturday, June 28, and recover from a very, very long flight. Some modest visitations may be made in the following days.

July 1 or 2

Essen, Germany

We will depart in late afternoon or early morning by plane from Stockholm to Essen, where considerable development has occurred as part of the industrial development in the post-war period.

July 3 or 4 Amsterdam, Netherlands-

We will depart on either late afternoon or early Friday, July 4, by train to Amsterdam. Approximately 2 hour trip.

The rest of the time will be spent in the Netherlands touring cities throughout the Netherlands, including Rotterdam, Utrecht, Amsterdam and the Hague.

July 9 Depart for Portland.
