WHEREAS, An increase in staffing levels for the Solid Waste Division is needed to implement the proposed reorganization and meet work program priorities of Metro; and

WHEREAS, Adequate funds are available to implement the reorganization and no new funds from local sources are required; now, therefore,

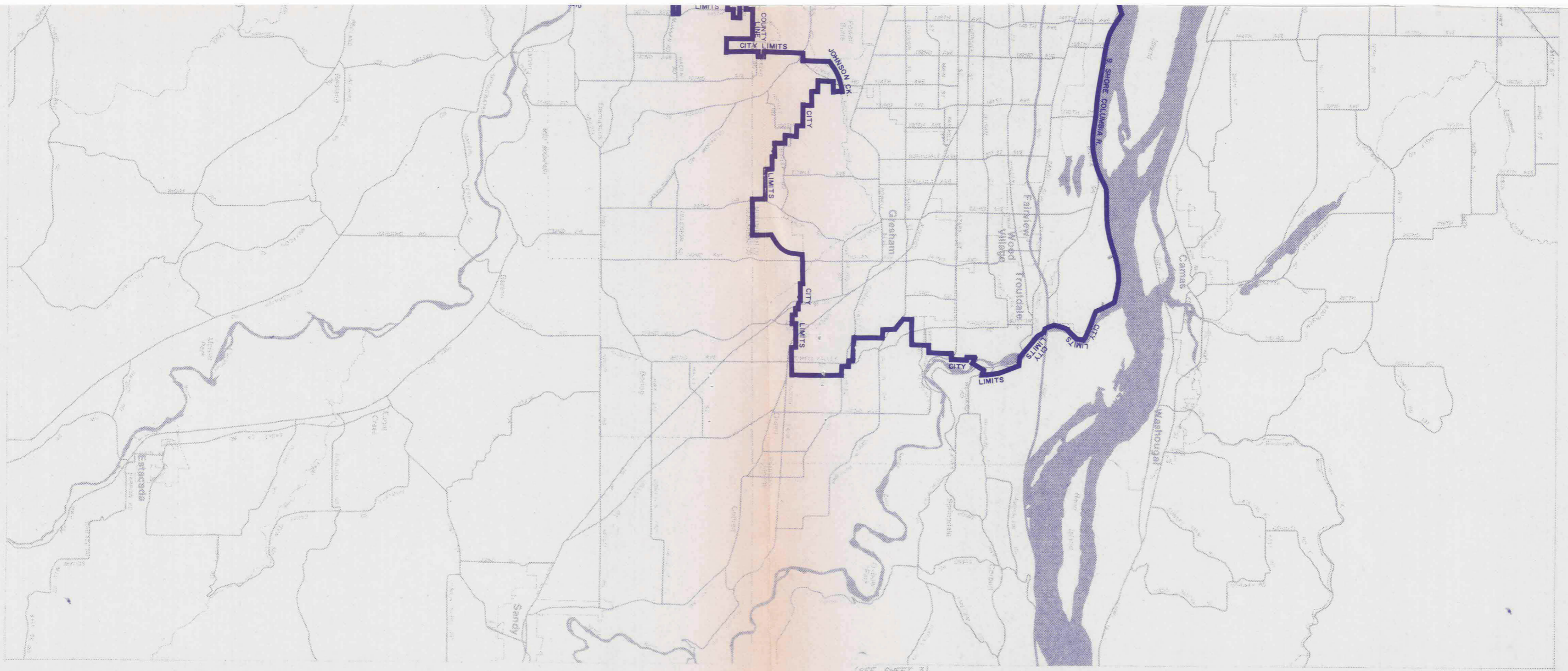
BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That Council agrees in concept with the reorganization plan for the Solid Waste Division.
2. That Council authorizes the establishment of three new permanent positions (Resource Recovery Project Manager, Solid Waste Engineer, and Solid Waste Technician) in the Solid Waste Division.

ADOPTED by the Council of the Metropolitan Service District this 25th day of October, 1979.

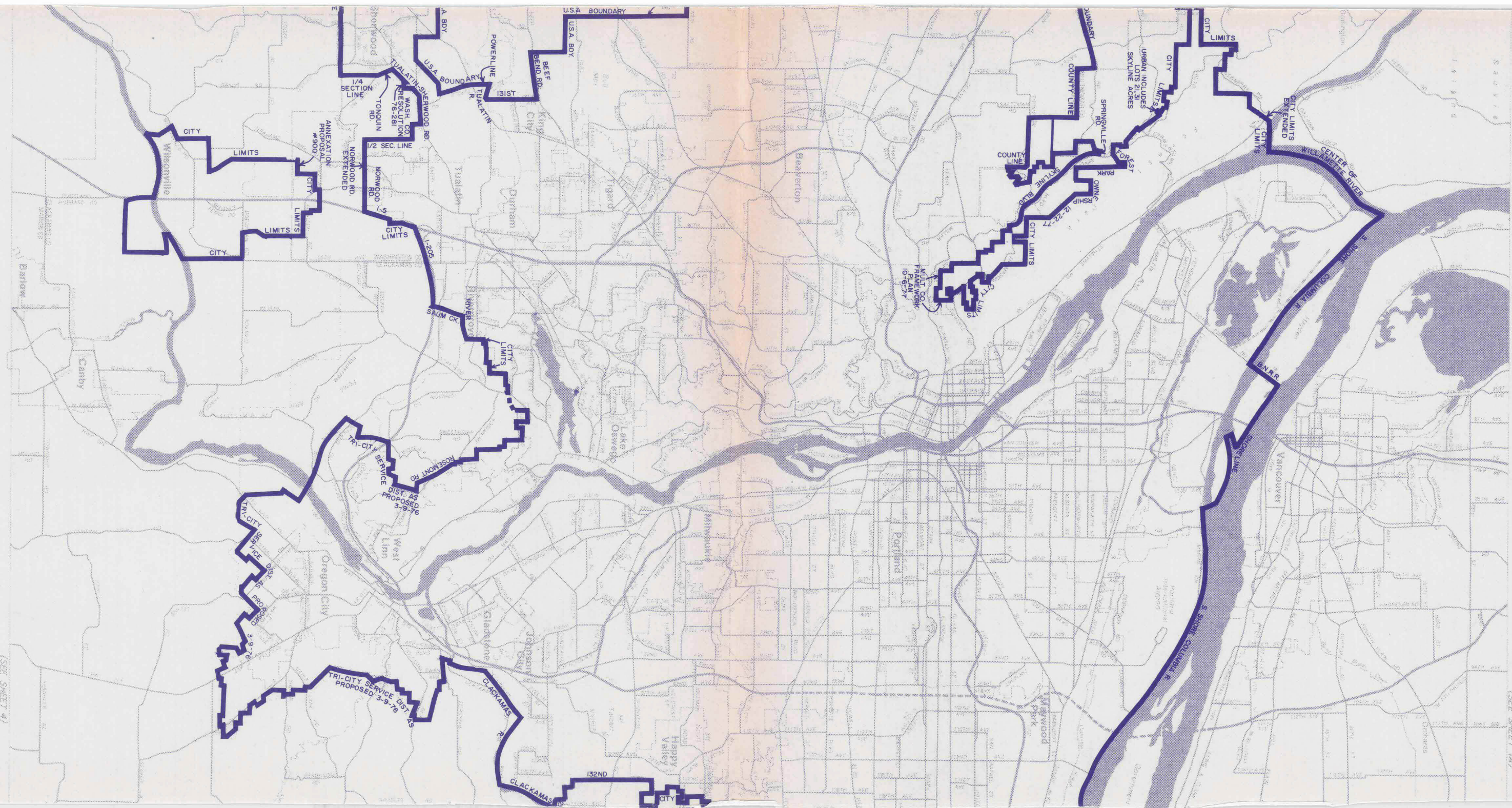
