WHEREAS, Staff analysis indicates that the proposed classification and redesignation of this segment of NE 60th Avenue is consistent with the adjacent facilities; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

 That the Metro Council amend the ITP to incorporate Exhibit A.

2. That the Metro Council amend the Functional Classification System to include NE 60th Ave. between Lombard and Columbia Blvd. as a Collector street.


3. That the FAUS be amended to include the noted segment.
