WHEREAS, The Metropolitan Service District (Metro) is leading a cooperative study to identify solutions to traffic problems in the Southern Corridor; and

WHEREAS, Metro staff evaluation has shown fixed guideway transit service to be a long-term possibility; and

WHEREAS, Tri-Met is the agency responsible for the provision of public transit service in the Portland metropolitan region; and

WHEREAS, Tri-Met staff has requested that the cooperative study evaluate the desirability of purchasing in the near-term future the Portland Traction Company right-of-way for later development of a fixed guideway project between Portland and Oregon City; now, therefore,

## BE IT RESOLVED,

- l. That the purchase in the near-term future of the Portland Traction Company right-of-way be evaluated as part of the Southern Corridor Transportation Study.
- 2. That the evaluation be completed by May, 1980, as part of the Southern Corridor Study.
- 3. That the Metro Council consider a recommendation from the Southern Corridor Working Group, made up of representatives from

ODOT, Tri-Met and affected local jurisdictions, at its meeting in May, 1980.
