BE IT RESOLVED

That the projects and programs described in the draft
FY 1980 TIP for the urban areas of Clark County and the draft
Determination of Air Quality Consistency are found by Metro Council
to be consistent with the policies, plans, and programs of the
Metropolitan Service District.

2. That the Clark County Regional Planning Council be advised of this concurrence.
