RESOLUTION NO. 80-128
Introduced by the
Ways and Means Committee

WHEREAS, There is a need to consolidate the existing Council Committee system to help improve the policy coordination between the various functional areas; and

WHEREAS, The Ways and Means Committee has reviewed alternative ways of restructuring the Committee system to achieve this objective and has endorsed a three Committee system; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That a Council Planning Committee be established to monitor and propose policy direction for all planning and development activities in the areas of Metropolitan Development, Transportation and Public Facilities.
2. That the special role of the Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation (JPACT) be recognized by the Council, and that the Council recommend that this Committee continue with two (2) Council representatives.
3. That a Council Service Delivery Committee be established to monitor and propose policy direction for all activities in the areas of the Zoo and Solid Waste.
4. That a Coordinating Committee be established to monitor and propose policy direction for Criminal Justice, general management and procedural issues which cross other Committee

lines, and that membership on this Committee consist of the Council Presiding Officer, Vice Presiding Office and representatives of the two other Council Committees.

5. That the work of these standing Committees be supplemented with special committees or task forces as needed and as approved by the whole Council.

6. That the Council rules be amended to reflect this three Committee system.

ADOPTED by the Council of the Metropolitan Service District this 14th day of February, 1980.
