WHEREAS, The Metro Solid Waste Management Plan (SWMP) outlines a general policy of supporting waste reduction through the implementation of resource recovery and recycling; and

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 925 requires Solid Waste Management authorities receiving State funding assistance to establish goals and submit a waste reduction program to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ); and

WHEREAS, The Metro Council adopted Resolution No. 81-212 which adopted the Waste Reduction Plan and directed staff to implement the proposed plan in phases; and

WHEREAS, Metro does not currently have sufficient staff to implement the Waste Reduction Program; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That the positions of Clerk Typist 2, salary range 2.0 (\$9,853 - \$11,952), and Solid Waste Coordinator, salary range 11.0 (\$23,612 - \$28,742), be authorized in the Solid Waste Department.

2. That the amount of \$253,200 to fund the first year implementation of the Waste Reduction Plan be appropriated immediately.

3. That the funding included in the Waste Reduction Plan for the Southeast Recycling Center and the Beaverton Recycling Center be subject to separate Council appropriation action.
