

## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

Before Metro Council to Consider a Measure 49 Claim

**Notice Date:** June 24 2008

**To:** Owners and occupants of property within 100 feet of the subject property, local government, claimant, and any person who has requested notice.

**Subject:** A claim has been filed with Metro pursuant to Ballot Measure 49. The claimant seeks compensation in the amount of \$425,000 for a reduction in fair market value of property owned by the claimant as a result of enforcement of Metro Code Section 3.07.1110 of Title 11. Metro Title 11 provides interim protection of areas brought into the Urban Growth Boundary. In lieu of compensation, the claimant seeks a waiver of that regulation so that the claimant can divide the 6.84-acre subject property into four single-family residential lots for the purpose of developing a single or multi-family dwelling on each lot that does not already contain a dwelling.
