WHEREAS, on November 9, 2000, the Metro Council adopted Ordinance No. 00-860A to establish the membership and terms of office for Metro advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, certain advisory committee term limitations do not apply to representatives of local governments; and

WHEREAS, various trade, professional and special interest organizations and associations have historically been represented on Metro advisory committees; and

WHEREAS, representatives of stakeholder organizations contribute valuable technical expertise to the work of Metro advisory committees; now, therefore,

THE METRO COUNCIL ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Metro Code Section 2.19.030(c) is amended to read as follows:

“(c) Terms.

- (1) All appointments made by the Executive Officer or members of the Council shall be for a term of two (2) years or to fill a vacancy in the remaining portion of a term not to exceed two (2) years.
- (2) No person may be appointed to serve more than two (2) consecutive full two (2) year terms on the same committee nor may any person be appointed to fill more than one partial term on any one committee. ~~However, employees of agencies serving as the nominees of their employer are not subject to these limitations on terms.~~
- (3) The limitations on terms set forth in subsection (2) shall not apply to:
  - (a) employees of public agencies serving as the representative of their public employer; or

(b) representatives of associations, cooperatives, or other non-profit groups, provided such group continues to re-nominate the designated representative every two years.

~~(3)~~(4) Members shall continue to serve until their successor is appointed and confirmed.”

## **STAFF REPORT**

CONSIDERATION OF ORDINANCE NO. 02-960, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AMENDING METRO CODE CHAPTER 2.19 TO MODIFY THE TERM LIMITATION PROVISIONS APPLICABLE TO METRO ADVISORY COMMITTEES AND TO ENLARGE THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE SOLID WASTE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

### **Background**

The proposed ordinance would amend Metro Code Chapter 2.19 create an exception to the current limitations on the number of terms that may be served on Metro advisory committees for individuals representing certain employers or types of organizations. Specifically the limitations would not be applicable to employees of public employers that represent their employer or representatives of associations, cooperatives or other non-profit groups. The ordinance also would add a Clark County hauler to the list of non-voting members on the Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

### **Analysis/Information**

**Legal Background.** The Council enacted Metro Code Chapter 2.19 in November 2000. The purpose of the new chapter was to assemble code provisions related to Metro advisory committees in a single location and clarify the appointment process, membership and terms of office for committee members. Section 2.19.030(c) limits the length of service for committee members to two-two year terms. The membership of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee is set forth in Section 2.19.130(b). The REM staff periodically review the membership of the committee and make recommendations for additions or deletions.

**Anticipated Effect.** Many Metro advisory committees have positions that are appointed by specific local jurisdictions or groups of jurisdictions. Many committee positions also are filled by direct appointment by an organization, association or group or such entities are asked to recommend an appointee for a position. Many local governments prefer to appoint employees that have specific expertise that relate to the purpose of a particular advisory committee. In addition, organizations, associations and other groups often wish to appoint members of their staff, such as an executive director, to represent them on committees. In both cases, they desire to have the appointed individual serve for as long as he or she is employed by the jurisdiction or organization.

The solid waste systems of the Metro region and Clark County, Washington are becoming increasingly linked together. For example, there are several non-system licenses that allow Portland-based haulers to take material to disposal facilities in Clark County, disposal facilities would like to access Metro's system fee credit program and Metro processes latex paint collected in Clark County. A representative of Clark County's solid waste regulatory staff has served as a non-voting SWAC member. As recognition that Metro solid waste decisions more frequently affect Clark County haulers and disposal facilities, REM staff is recommending that a Clark County hauler be appointed as a non-voting SWAC member.

3. That the voters of the Metro Region have elected Alexis Dow for the position of Metro Auditor Officer for a term commencing January 1, 2003 and ending on December 31, 2005;
4. That the voters of the Metro Region District 1 have elected Rod Park for the position of Metro Councilor Officer for a term commencing on January 1, 2003 and ending on December 31, 2005;
5. That the voters of the Metro Region District 2 have nominated Brian Newman and Bill Atherton as candidates for the position of Metro Councilor at the General Election to be held on November 5, 2002;

6. That the voters of the Metro Region District 4 have elected Susan McLain for the position of Metro Councilor Officer for a term commencing January 1, 2003 and ending on December 31, 2005;

7. That the voters of the Metro Region have defeated Ballot Measure 26-11; and

8. That the voters of the Metro Region have approved of Ballot Measure 26-29.

### BACKGROUND

Metro must pass a resolution accepting the official abstract of votes and notify the Multnomah County Elections Division, as required by state law.

### ANALYSIS/INFORMATION

The Metro Council passed Resolution No. 00-2988 on September 7, 2000 and Resolution No. 02-3163 on February 14, 2002. These actions resulted in the submittal to the voters of Ballot Measure 26-11, an amendment to the Metro Charter to prohibit, repeal Metro housing density requirements, and Measure 26-29, an amendment to the Metro Charter Requiring Protection of Existing Single Family Neighborhoods, Cost Impact Statements Regarding Urban Growth Boundary Amendments, and Notice to Affected Neighborhoods. Ballot Measure 26-11 was defeated and Measure 26-29 was approved by the voters during the May 21, 2002 primary election.

**Known Opposition** – none.

1. **Legal Antecedents** - ORS 225.295 requires that Metro shall determine the results of the Primary Election, based on the abstract of votes, and notify the Multnomah County Elections Division.
2. **Anticipated Effects** – Passage of Measure 26-29 will require ordinance and resolutions to implement.
3. **Budget Impacts** – There is no budget impact associated with the adoption of Resolution No. 02-3208.

### RECOMMENDED ACTION

Staff recommends that the Metro Council pass this resolution.

**3. ANNUAL VOLUNTEER PROGRAM REPORT**

Charles Ciecko, Director of Parks of Greenspaces, said they established the volunteer program four years ago. He noted the level of volunteer leadership that had developed over the four years. They were fortunate to have citizens in this region whom cared so much by donating their time.

Lupine Hudson and Mary West, Parks and Greenspaces Program Managers of Volunteer Services, presented Metro's Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department Volunteer Program Year-end Report 2001 (a copy is found in the meeting record). Ms. Hudson said their word for the year was symbiosis and explained why. She talked about the volunteer naturalists, annual training, and the need for long term volunteers. She gave an overview of creation of the Nature University Program, which included a course catalogue and the program's curriculum. The effort had created an extended educational experience. She then introduced Deb Scriven, Environmental Educational Coordinator.

Deb Scriven, Parks and Greenspaces Program, shared her experience about training the volunteers. She highlighted the benefits of the Nature University Programs and the lessons they had learned by offering the naturalist training. Ms. West talked about the 15-hour training for crew leaders, which included leading a work party, restoration practices and other components of the program. They had combined the training with the naturalist training. She introduced Jeff Locke, a volunteer who exemplified their program's goals. He had had the opportunity to teach the volunteers as well as lead.

Jeff Locke, volunteer, thanked the Council for the opportunity to do the volunteer work. The new crew leaders were amazing. The program the new leaders went through was more intensive and it showed in the results out in the field. He talked about his own experience as a volunteer. He noted how wonderful Metro's staff naturalists were. He was now a site steward at Smith and Bybee Lakes. Ms. West talked about the site steward program. She introduced the Nystrom family.

Pat, Stephanie, Zoe, Parker and Marshall Nystrom, volunteers, talked about the volunteer experience in the Gresham area. Pat said that it was a good community experience, he got to

know his neighbors better and he became acquainted with Metro's vision. Stephanie said they had volunteered for about a year and half and had been around the region with that work. She noted her favorite thing about volunteering was the ability to see something accomplished in a day. Parker said their volunteer work was a time for bonding with his family and he liked eradicating invasive plants. Councilor Park asked Ms. Parker to talk about her other volunteer experience in Gresham. Ms. Parker said they had been working on preserving the Hogan Butte area and explained in detail some of what they had done. Councilor Park updated the Council on the Hogan Butte purchase.

Ms. West acknowledged their office volunteers and talked about what they had accomplished which included designing a tracking database. Ms. Hudson added that everyone was playing into the work that others were doing, symbiosis truly represented the system they worked in. She also talked about what the volunteers got in return.

Councilor McLain thanked Ms. Hudson and Ms. West for their efforts. "One person with passion was worth 40 people who were interested." She really saw the volunteers' passion in their volunteer efforts at Metro.
