WHEREAS, Metro staff prepares cost analyses of potential future solid waste projects to serve the region; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That future studies regarding Metro solid waste disposal rates include a cost of service analysis unless otherwise directed by the Council.

2. That future cost analyses regarding present or future Metro solid waste facilities include a cost of service analysis unless otherwise directed by the Council.
