ISSUE & BACKGROUND

Sunrise Project is being studied to accomplish two principal travel objectives:

- 1) Provide east-west transportation improvements from I-205 at Highway 224 to the Rock Creek Junction to meet existing and future safety, connectivity, and capacity needs for the statewide and regional travel within the OR 212/224 Corridor.
- 2) Provide transportation improvements that support the viability of the Clackamas area for industrial uses.

The Sunrise Project Environmental Impact Statement looks at providing a new facility that connects from I-205 at Highway 224 to the Rock Creek Junction. The Sunrise Project substantially improves OR 212/224 corridor performance. Sunrise build alternatives assume substantial improvements to the OR 212/82nd Drive intersection. Other local improvement projects are included in the build alternatives. An Interchange Access Management Plan process is on-going, and will identify additional refinements for study.

OPTIONS AVAILABLE

Alternative 1 - No Build

Alternative 2 - Six-lane facility without a mid-point interchange.

Alternative 3 – Six-lane facility with a mid-point interchange.

The project has not yet identified a locally preferred alternative (LPA) and is looking to brief the Metro Council on the project prior to the selection of the LPA.
