4. ORDINANCES – FIRST READING

Council President Bragdon assigned Ordinance No. 09-1220 to Council.

Andy Shaw, Infrastructure Finance Manager, presented a Powerpoint to Council (see attachments).

Councilor Liberty introduced the ordinance to Councilors. He described tax revenue specifics, projects and processes impacted, and expansion area issues.

Council President Bragdon opened a public hearing on Ordinance No. 09-1220.

Susan Anderson, Director of Portland Bureau of Sustainable Development, provided testimony on the City of Portland's support for Ordinance No. 09-1220 and extending Metro's construction excise tax. She said it was a valuable resource generating tax in dire economic times.

Council President Bragdon momentarily closed the public hearing.

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Councilors Burkholder and Hosticka discussed the need to define purpose of the tax and identify various revenue and resource streams. Councilors further discussed project specifics and addressed expansion area topics. Councilor Liberty discussed project prioritization and not stretching revenue too thin as to defeat the goal and mission of extending the tax. Councilor Collette stressed the need to fund projects that leverage regional sustainability and collaboration.

Council President Bragdon resumed the public hearing.
