June 20 Council Work Session on Disposal System Planning

SWAC members and alternates are encouraged to attend the June 20 Metro Council work session on Disposal System Planning. At the meeting, the project consultant from CH2M Hill will release the major findings of the Metro Transfer System Ownership Study. The report provides the analysis of three alternative transfer station ownership models for the Metro area. The three models (public, private, mixed public and private) are evaluated against:

- 1. Metro Council values for key attributes of system performance;
- 2. Cost and system economics; and
- 3. Risk associated with implementation.

Following the consultant's presentation, system stakeholders, including some members of SWAC, will be invited to provide comments on the report, describe system attributes most important to them, and engage in a discussion with the Metro Council.

SWAC will officially be weighing in on the report and any study recommendations in late summer or early fall. This work session provides a good opportunity to hear an overview of the alternative system models and a discussion about those alternatives.

The meeting will be in the Metro Council Chambers and the Disposal System Planning topic is scheduled to start around 3:15 pm and end near 5:00 pm.
