SUBJECT: Administrative Interpretation of the Urban

Growth Boundary South of Cornelius

AUTHORITY: Section 3, Metro Ordinance No. 81-105

FINDINGS OF FACT

This administrative interpretation relates to the location of the UGB in the S. E. 1/4 Section 4, TlS, R3W, W.M., Tax Lot 100.

- 1. The UGB in this area was established at the time the UGB was first adopted by CRAG in December 1976.
- 2. The UGB in this particular case is described as following the floodplain boundaries as shown on Washington County 1974 floodplain maps (see Exhibit "A").
- 3. The County's 1974 floodplain maps include the following notation:

"THE FLOOD PLAIN LOCATION AND ELEVATIONS ON THESE MAPS ARE SUBJECT TO PRECISE LOCATION IN THE FIELD AS PROVIDED IN SECTION 135-1.1 OF THE ZONING ARTICLE."

4. Section 135-1.1 of the Washington County Zoning Article follows:

"135.1.1 Delineation of the flood plain including the floodway and floodway fringe area shall be established by a Registered Engineer, from the flood surface elevations provided by the Director of Public Works. Such delineation shall be based on mean sea level datum and be field located from recognized valid bench marks. The delineation shall then be submitted to the Director of Public Works for review."

5. Metro's UGB map series includes a similar reference to the County's floodplain maps and Zoning Article as follows:

"Where the UGB is defined by floodplain boundaries as shown on Washington County 1974 floodplain maps, the precise location of the UGB shall be determined by field survey based upon floodplain elevations in 1974 as defined by the Washington County Director of Public Works following the procedures provided in Section 135-1.1 of the Washington County Zoning Article."

- 6. The floodplain boundary as shown on the Washington County 1974 floodplain map (scale: 1" = 1000'), and as shown on Metro's UGB map (scale: 1" = 200') is similar.
- 7. The floodplain information for Washington County was updated in 1982 with the Washington County Flood Insurance Study. The effective date of the maps from this study is September 30, 1982. Washington County has recently adopted a new Community Development Code, Ordinance No. 264, adopted June 28, 1983. The new Code includes by reference the updated floodplain maps as representing the floodplain areas of Washington County.
- 8. The applicant has submitted a map indicating the 100-year floodplain has been established by field survey (Exhibit "B"). The location of the floodplain shown in Exhibit "B" is similar to that shown on the current Washington County Flood Insurance Study maps (Exhibit "C") which is different from that shown on the 1974 Floodplain Series.
- 9. The location of the floodplain has been established by field survey and that location is supported by the Washington County Flood Insurance Study maps.

CONCLUSION AND ORDER

The UGB in this area is hereby interpreted to follow the elevation of the 100-year floodplain as established by field survey and as generally shown on Exhibit "D."
