

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 73**

**EFFECTIVE DATE:** October 1999

**SUBJECT: ANNEXATION TO THE JURISDICTIONAL BOUNDARY FEE**

**Purpose**

This order establishes the fee structure for annexation to the Metro jurisdictional boundary consistent with and as required by Metro Code section 3.09.110 (c).

**Background**

The Metro Charter and State law, especially, but not limited to the provisions of the ORS 268.354, have established Metro as having certain responsibilities with regard to adjustment to the district boundary. Metro Code section 3.09.110(c) states that:

*“The Metro Executive Officer shall establish a fee structure for establishing the amounts to be paid upon filing notice of city or county adoption of boundary changes, appeals to the Boundary Appeals Commission and for related services.”*


**Fee Structure**

In order to cover the necessary costs associated with Metro tasks to annex property to the jurisdictional boundary by the Metro Council, the following fee is established:

Fee for annexation to the Metro jurisdictional boundary: \$3,000

Such fee shall be paid upon filing an application for annexation to the Metro jurisdictional boundary and will be used to reimburse Metro costs for staff time, materials, public notices, and administrative costs as well as excise tax upon such costs. Appeals will be processed on a cost recovery basis. Any amount remaining after the completion of the Metro tasks shall be refunded to the appealing party.
