4.1 **Ordinance No. 10-1234,** For the Purpose of Amending the FY 2009-10 Budget and Appropriations Schedule to Add 1.0 FTE Natural Resources Technician to Support Stabilization Activities on Newly Acquired Chehelam Ridge Natural Area and Declaring an Emergency.

Councilor Harrington introduced the ordinance, including background on the Chehelam Ridge land acquisition. She discussed stewardship and position funding. She described the ordinance's role authorizing funds and transferring funds. Councilor Burkholder asked about ranger and staff reporting for the area, considering its large size and distance from

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Metro Regional Center. Kathleen Brennan-Hunter, Conservation Director, provided staffing background and natural areas management information. Councilor Liberty asked about fire protection issues. Councilors discussed unwanted uses of the area.

President Bragdon opened a public hearing on Ordinance No. 10-1234.

President Bragdon closed the public hearing.

Councilor Harrington closed discussion on Ordinance No. 10-1234.
