Councilor McLain said this was an ordinance we had to do annually. This was a housekeeping matter as there were no changes from the previous year. Councilor Burkholder spoke to the resolution giving an overview of the goals and purposes of the project and advisory committee appointments. Councilor McLain noted that one of the reasons that this task force was important was to help this highway work better. Council President Bragdon said this was a good step. He noted the importance of transportation planning. He acknowledged the list of individuals who were willing to spend their time working on this project. Councilor Burkholder supported Councilor McLain's comments. They were looking at land use issues as well better access.

Councilors Park, Burkholder, McLain, Monroe, Newman and Council President Bragdon voted in support of the motion. The vote was 6 aye, the motion passed.
