- SUMMARY: Two action items were included in the agenda as follows:
- 1. Allocating Interstate Transfer Funds from the Southern Corridor Reserve

All members voted yes on the two items with the following comments:

- . Mr. Larry Cole (Beaverton) indicated that the project sponsor for the new Murray Boulevard project should be changed to Washington County and should not be a joint Washington County/Beaverton project.
- . Mr. Vern Veysey (Clark County) voted yes on the action items but requested an A-95 Review comment be included that future actions allocating Interstate Transfer funding to a <u>new</u> project should be discussed by JPACT and the proposed Bi-State Policy Committee.

The results of the telephone poll were reviewed with Charlie Williamson, JPACT Chairman. Mr. Williamson concurred in the results for transmittal to the full Metro Council for adoption.
