> At the TPAC meeting on Friday, a number of changes were made to the material previously mailed to you. The enclosed packet contains these changes. Specifically, the changes are:

1. Agenda Item 1 - TPAC Bylaws

The responsibilities of TPAC with respect to air quality planning are proposed to be changed to clarify TPAC's role relative to the role of the Air Quality Advisory Committee. Clark County Regional Planning Council and the city of Vancouver are also shown as members of TPAC.

2. Agenda Item 2 - Westside Corridor

The resolution would be changed to designate a transitway in the Interim Transportation Plan rather than light rail transit.

The resolution would also propose an "analysis aimed at identifying needed highway and road modifications with the transitway options" as recommended by the Westside Transitway Steering Group.

An attachment was recommended which describes work to be undertaken by various agencies and governments in carrying out the Phase II analysis through June 30, 1980. It is understood that further detailing of this work program will be coordinated through the Westside Project Management Committee.

3. Agenda Item 4 - Metro Reserve

While TPAC recommended the allocation of the reserve account, the funding distribution was changed to account for revised cost estimates provided by Multnomah County.
