3. <u>CITY OF HILLSBORO VIRTUAL TOUR</u>

Mr. John Southgate and Mr. Colin Cooper of the City of Hillsboro provided a virtual tour presentation of the City. Using different properties in Hillsboro – for example the Hillsboro Civic Center, Venetian Theatre and Tanasbourne/AmberGlen area – the presenters illustrated the City's work on issues such as economic development, urban renewal districts, affordable housing, multiuse facilities, Transit Oriented Development and transit access.

Council discussion included funding for projects with urban renewal monies versus property tax, affordable housing, collaboration with the City of Beaverton regarding Tanasbourne/AmberGlen, and investing in projects that will attract other investments that could generate money.

Councilor Park introduced Resolution No. 10-4216. The East Metro Connections Plan is the first mobility corridor refinement plan to come out of the 2035 Regional Transportation Plan that will incorporate the goals and approach of Metro's mobility corridor strategy designed to better integrate land use, community and economic development, environmental and transportation goals at the corridor refinement plan stage. The process is anticipated to take 18 months and the steering committee is comprised of 19 members from partner jurisdictions (i.e. TriMet and Port of Portland) and community organizations (i.e. freight interests and neighborhood associations).
