## Over \$630 million/year on Transportation

- Maintenance and preservation
- Lombard Street railroad overcrossing
- I-5/I-17/Kruseway Interchange
- LRT to airport and North Portland
- Banks to Vernonia Trail; Springwater





## Challenges and Opportunities

- What we expect
  - 1 million more people by 2030
  - Demographic changes (Ave HH size shrinking; Avo ago increasing)
  - Economic changes (Service economy)
  - Increasing globalization of trade
- What we don't know
  - Effect of energy pricing, national debt, new technologies...



## Scoping . . . what we heard

- Begin with community values
- Validate the forecast
- Improve understanding of market forces
- Target and leverage public investments

- Improve the UGB process



## Proposed New Look Outcomes

- Validate Community Values
- Verify the forecast
- Study market factors and develop focused investment strategies
- New tools to finance planning/infrastructure
- Long-term view on regional landscape
- More predictable UGB process that reinforces regional and local goals.



## New Look Work Program: Investing In our communities

- Identify roles of centers, corridors, employment areas in meeting community/regional needs
- Identify areas that are "ripe" for development
- Pursue focused investment strategies



## New Look Work Program: Shape of our region

- Identify and map potential urban areas, natural and agricultural resources we value
- Implement tools/strategies to sustain agricultural industry; protect greenspaces; preserve land for future development
- Establish more predictable UGB process

## 2006: Research and Policy

- Assess ways to promote job growth, economic vitality
- Identify opportunities/barriers to efficient land use
- Integrate transportation planning with economic/community/environmental goals
- Identify natural, urban and agricultural lands needs
- Investigate new tools



## 2007: Initiate Implementation

- Pursue legislative agenda
- Pursue funding strategies
- Update concept map and policies to support vision
- Integrate vision with RTP update
- Pursue tools to support housing choice and affordability, job creation, economic vitality
- Pursue strategies to support agricultural economy, protect natural features and plan for urbanization.



## 2008: Implementation

- Strategic investment in communities
- Adopt new tools (urban reserves, rural reserves, hard edges) to supplement UGB process
- Make UGB decision – December 2008
- Adopt Regional Transportation Plan
