4.2 **Ordinance No. 12-1291**, For the Purpose of Amending the FY 2012-13 Budget and Appropriations Schedule to Provide Funding for Land Use Application Planning and Design Steps Needed for a Publically Accessible Tualatin River Canoe Launch at the River Road Natural Area Location.

Second read, public hearing and Council consideration and vote are scheduled for Oct. 18. Councilor Carl Hosticka was assigned carrier for the legislation.

5. <u>CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER COMMUNICATION</u>

Ms. Martha Bennett provided the following updates:

- Zoo members will receive a letter shortly outlining the new parking policy for Washington Park. Parking at the Oregon Zoo will no longer be free for Zoo members beginning in spring 2013.
- Mr. Tim Collier has agreed to serve as Interim Director of Finance and Regulatory Services starting Nov. 1. Ms. Margo Norton has announced her retirement effective Oct. 31.
- The Oregon Marine Board has agreed to reimburse Metro \$54,000 for costs accrued during the deconstruction of a derelict barge, known as the Vancouver Yacht Club.
- She also shared a few comments on the Oct. 11 University of Oregon Economic Forum.

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6. <u>COUNCILOR COMMUNICATION</u>

Councilor updates included the following recent meetings and/or events with the Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation (JPACT), Metro Policy Advisory Committee (MPAC), Transit Oriented Development (TOD) Steering Committee, and Regional Park Providers. Additional updates included the recent summer MPAC tours of St. Johns, the Troutdale Reynolds Industrial Park, and Southwest Corridor Project, and opening of the Hawthorne Park in Clackamas County. Highlighted upcoming events included The Intertwine Alliance Summit scheduled for Oct. 25.
