

IN CONSIDERATION OF RESOLUTION NO. 12-XXXX, FOR THE PURPOSE OF AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER TO APPROVE THE DEDICATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAY AT GLENDOVEER GOLF COURSE TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND

BACKGROUND

Metro acquired Glendoveer Golf Course and fitness trail located at the corner of NE Glisan Street and NE 148th Avenue from Multnomah County in 1994 .

In order to provide for access to the crosswalks spanning NE Glisan Street and NE 148th Avenue, the city requires a right of way dedication of eight (8) square feet of sidewalk at the southeast corner of the golf course. The dedication will allow construction of a five foot wide sidewalk and ADA accessible ramps at the corner of NE 148th Avenue and NE Glisan Street. The corner ramps and connection to existing sidewalks will require temporary removal of fencing on the perimeter of the golf course and will require construction of a small retaining wall due to grade issues.

Construction of the sidewalk and ramps have public safety benefits for neighbors, trail and transit users. This small project is consistent with regional transportation goals and is supported by the nearby neighborhood associations. All costs for these improvements will be borne by the City of Portland.

- 2. **Legal Antecedents** Metro Council Resolution No. 97-2539B, "For the Purpose of Approving General Policies Related to the Review of Easements, Right of Ways, and Leases for Non-Park Uses through Properties Managed by the Regional Parks and Greenspaces Department."
- 3. **Anticipated Effects** Adoption of the right-of-way dedication will allow the city improved access to for the disabled, pedestrians and bicycles to the crosswalks spanning NE Glisan Street and 148th Avenue. This will provide for a wider sidewalk making it safer and more convenient to access the fitness trail.
- 4. **Budget Impacts** There are no costs to implement this legislation or will result from the dedication.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

The Chief Operating Officer recommends approval of Resolution 12-4373 to provide a wider sidewalk and better access to the sidewalks.
