WHEREAS, Federal-Aid Urban (FAU) FY 1989 allocations have been received for the region and for the City of Portland; and

WHEREAS, This FY 1989 allocation has been projected into FY 1990 and FY 1991 in order to provide an adequate funding base for programming of projects; and

WHEREAS, The region allocation (less \$500,000 holdback for contingencies) has been suballocated with 75 percent based upon population and 25 percent by region priority; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit "A" has been prepared to reflect the suballocations and projects to which assigned; now, therefore,

1. That the Council of the Metropolitan Service District authorizes FY 1989 to FY 1991 FAU funds at the 75 percent "minimum allocation" to:

RESOLUTION NO. 89-1064, ALLOCATING FEDERAL-AID URBAN FUNDS FOR FY 1989 TO 1991

Date: March 15, 1989 Presented By: Councilor Bauer

<u>COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION</u>: At the March 23, 1989 meeting, all Intergovernmental Committee members were present -- Councilors Collier, DeJardin, Devlin, Gardner and myself -- and voted unanimously to recommend Council adoption of Resolution No. 89-1064.

Transportation Department Director COMMITTEE DISCUSSION & ISSUES: Andy Cotugno presented the resolution which allocates three years of the region's Federal-Aid Urban (FAU) funds to Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington Counties' projects and identifies City of Portland projects which will use designated City FAU funds. The staff report attached outlines the specific projects and allocations. A \$500,000 "holdback" of funds has been included to cover funding uncertainties for FY1990-1991 years. Mr. Cotugno explained FAU funds can be spent on most of the region's arterials and collectors and the State's allocation to the region is based on a population formula. Under Federal law, the City of Portland receives a designated portion of the funds with the remainder going to the region. With the last FAU allocation in 1988, JPACT established a policy involving the three counties in determining the specific uses of 75 percent of the regional funding and leaving 25 percent to be used on a discretionary basis for agree-upon project This resolution approves the specific projects within the 75 percent share to the counties. In a few months another resolution will come to the Council to approve allocation for projects under the remaining 25 percent.

Mr. Cotugno noted each project has gone through its respective county's transportation approval process, with each county presenting a consolidated recommendation. Transportation's Technical Policy Advisory Committee also recommends approval of Resolution No. 89-1064.

#### PROPOSED ACTION

This resolution would: 1) allocate three years of the region's (Multnomah, Clackamas and Washington Counties) Federal-Aid Urban (FAU) funds to projects and reserves; and 2) identify City of Portland projects which are to use the City's allocated FAU funds.

TPAC and JPACT have reviewed this proposed allocation and recommend approval of Resolution No. 89-1064.

#### FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

1. The TIP Subcommittee has prepared a program of projects to use FY 1989-FY 1991 allocations of FAU funds. The formula for distribution of the funds calls for each county in the Metro region to receive at least a 75 percent "minimum allocation" based upon population (75 percent of the funds allocated based upon population, 25 percent by region priority). In addition, staff has recommended "holding back" \$500,000 of the funds to allow for uncertainties in funding levels actually available in the FY 1990 to FY 1991 years. By following this procedure, the allocations would yield:
