WHEREAS, Metro Code Section 2.02.145 requires the Executive Officer to prepare a Pay Plan for non-represented District employees for approval by The Council of the Metropolitan Service District; and

WHEREAS, Metro Code Section 2.02.275 established personnel rules for Zoo Visitor Services employees which among other things requires Visitor Services employees to be paid at a rate in the pay plan approved by the Council; and

WHEREAS, The Council has approved a separate pay schedule (Table S) for seasonal Zoo Visitor Services employees, the beginning rate of which is in conformance with the State minimum wage; and

WHEREAS, The State of Oregon has increased the State minimum wage effective January 1, 1990 to \$4.25 per hour which is \$.40 higher than the beginning rate on the existing seasonal Visitor Services play plan schedule; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

1. That the Pay Plan schedule for non-represented Zoo seasonal Visitor Services employees is amended and approved as shown on Exhibit A attached hereto.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND AND ANALYSIS

The last session of the Oregon legislature adopted a new minimum wage schedule which will be effective January 1, 1990. The accompanying resolution establishes the beginning rate of pay for Visitor Services Workers at \$4.25 per hour effective January 1, 1990 and maintains the pay plan with the appropriate steps as provided for in the pay plan.

Staff recommends adoption of this plan which brings it into conformance with the State of Oregon's minimum wage requirement.

RESOLUTION NO. 90-1192, ADOPTING THE FY 1989-90 PAY PLAN FOR ZOO VISITOR SERVICES WORKERS

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION: At its December 21, 1989 meeting, the Committee voted unanimously to recommend adoption of Resolution No. 90-1192. Voting yes were Councilors Collier, Devlin, Gardner, Wyers and Van Bergen.

COMMITTEE DISCUSSION/ISSUES: John Leahy, Personnel Manager, presented the staff report on the Resolution. He explained to the Committee the need to bring the pay plan for the Zoo Visitor Services Workers into conformance with the State of Oregon's minimum wage requirement. The new minimum wage became effective January 1, 1990. The resolution and accompanying Exhibit A (copy attached) maintain the pay plan with the appropriate steps as provided for in Metro's pay plan.
