WHEREAS, In December of 1991 the Council of the Metropolitan Service District adopted Resolution No. 91-1537, authorizing the Executive Officer to execute purchase of the former Sears Building in Northeast Portland for renovation and use as Metro's Headquarters; and

WHEREAS, The renovation project preparing the former Sears Building for occupancy by Metro is called the Metro Headquarters Project; and

WHEREAS, "Metro Headquarters" is acceptable as a name for the construction project but is not acceptable as the long-term name for the building; and

WHEREAS, The name, "Metro Center" is an appropriate name for Metro's new office building, having the virtues of being short, descriptive, and easily identifiable; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED,

By the Council of the Metropolitan Service District, that Metro's office building at 600 N.E. Grand Avenue is named "Metro Center."
