# **DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES**

- 1. Provides complete floor care service for the Oregon Convention Center including but not limited to carpet, ceramic tile, marble, terrazzo and concrete.
- 2. Operates large area extractor, vacuum, stripper, buffer and window washing equipment.
- 3. Strips, mops and waxes ceramic tile floors in restroom areas.
- 4. Maintain carpets using extracting and/or bonneting equipment.
- 5. Provides relief to route janitorial staff.
- 6. Operates walk-behind floor scrubber.
- 7. Hones marble using low speed rotary machine.
- 8. Uses dust mop, wet mop, dust pans, push broom and straw broom.
- 9. Manages custodial projects to allow the facility to open on schedule.
- 10. Communicates project needs with co-workers and supervisors.
- 11. Performs other duties as assigned.
