WHEREAS, on November 5, 2014, the City of Wood Village requested an extension of time to comply with the planning requirements of the Regional Transportation Functional Plan (RTFP); and

WHEREAS, Metro Code Section 3.08.620 establishes a process and criteria for extension of time for compliance with the RTFP and authorizes the Chief Operating Officer (COO) to grant an extension if the COO finds the city or county is making progress toward compliance or there is good cause for failure to meet the deadline for compliance; and

WHEREAS, the COO provided required notice of the proposed extension to the Oregon Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, the COO has provided the City of Wood Village one previous extension of time for completion of RTFP requirements; and

WHEREAS, Metro Code Section 3.08.620 establishes that the COO shall not grant more than two extensions of time; and

WHEREAS, the Metro Planning and Development Department has reviewed the application and recommends approval; and

WHEREAS, the COO finds, based upon the written recommendation of the Planning and Development Department, that the city meets the criteria for extensions; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The request of the City of Wood Village for an extension under Metro Code 3.08.620 to complete planning requirements pursuant to the RTFP is approved under the terms and conditions set forth in section 2 of this order.
- 2. The duration of the extension shall be until December 31, 2016.
