WHEREAS, The City of North Plains has acted to double the size of its urban growth boundary; and

WHEREAS, This action was appealed by 1000 Friends of Oregon, Department Land Conservation and Development, and Oregon Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, The Land Use Board of Appeals' decision on this appeal remanded the case to North Plains for numerous violations of Statewide Goals and Rules; and

WHEREAS, One of the bases for remand was inclusion of some of projected growth within the Metro boundary as a basis for the expansion of the City's urban growth boundary; now, therefore,

BE IS RESOLVED,

That the Office of General Counsel is authorized to seek permission and file with the Court of Appeals an amicus, "friend of the court," brief on behalf of Metro supporting LUBA's ruling requiring the City to coordinate any projected use of Metro growth.
