WHEREAS, Funds from a Federal grant through the City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services are available under Intergovernmental Agreement 905029 to reimburse Metro for most or all costs of certain projects that benefit the Columbia Slough adjacent to St. Johns Landfill; and

WHEREAS, The resolution was submitted to the Executive Officer for consideration and was forwarded to the Council for approval; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Metro Council authorizes the Executive Officer to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (Metro Contract No. 905029, attached as Exhibit A, B, C and D) with the City of Portland Bureau of Environmental Services for projects which benefit the Columbia Slough adjacent to St. Johns Landfill.
