

## METRO COUNCIL MEETING

Meeting Minutes December 3, 2015 Metro Regional Center, Council Chamber

Council President Tom Hughes called the regular council meeting to order at 2:40 p.m.

## 1. <u>CITIZEN COMMUNICATIONS</u>

<u>Art Lewellen, Portland</u>: Mr. Lewellen addressed the Council regarding his opposition to a bridge and Bertha Tunnel project as proposed in Seattle, providing a Plan B design instead.

<u>Nancy Shaw, Portland</u>: Ms. Shaw addressed the Council on issues relating to the Oregon Zoo elephants, specifically Chendra, and requested that she be released to a sanctuary.

<u>Annette Hadaway, Portland</u>: Ms. Hadaway discussed her experience growing up in Portland and going to the Oregon Zoo, requesting that Packy the elephant be retired and moved to a sanctuary in California.

<u>Dani Rukin, Portland</u>: Ms. Rukin addressed the Council regarding the Oregon Zoo elephants, specifically the impacts of the concerts and ZooLights on their well being.

# 2. CONSENT AGENDA

Council President Hughes, and Councilors Harrington, Craddick, Collette, Stacey, and Chase voted in support of the motion. The vote was 6 ayes, the motion <u>passed</u>.

#### 3. **RESOLUTIONS**

3.1 **Resolution No. 15-4662,** For the Purpose of Approving a Work Plan and Public Engagement Plan for the 2018 Regional Transportation Plan Update

Motion:	Councilor Kathryn Harrington moved to approve Resolution 15-4662.

I	Second:	Councilor Carlotta Collette seconded the motion.

Council President Hughes introduced Metro staff, Kim Ellis, to provide a brief presentation. Ms. Ellis gave an overview of the resolution, noting the engagement process with elected officials, local governments, and community and business leaders throughout the region to identify the transportation challenges, opportunities, and priorities for the 2018 Regional Transportation Plan Update to address. She described that additional input was received through a number of other activities and tools, including an online public opinion poll, stakeholder interviews, and discussion groups with historically underrepresented communities. Ms. Ellis added that the resolution had been recommended for the Council's approval by the Joint Policy Advisory Committee on Transportation and the Metro Policy Advisory Committee as well.

#### Council discussion:

Councilors thanked staff for their work on this resolution and project, discussing changing demographics in the region and the significance of transportation in keeping this region a great place to live, work, and play. Councilors also highlighted the outreach approach and the importance of involving local governments and regional partners.

Vote:

Council President Hughes, and Councilors Chase, Craddick, Stacey, and Harrington voted in support of the motion. The vote was 6 ayes, the motion passed.
