3.06: Fresh Water and Sewerage Management

Similar to its engagement with the issue of criminal justice, CRAG sought funding to conduct studies and bring about regional improvements in the areas of fresh water management and sewerage treatment. As far as the limited number of materials in the CRAG collection on these issues indicates, however, CRAG's success with having a deep effect in this area was relatively small.

3.08. Creation of Metropolitan Service District

Contrasting with the policy-oriented and higher-level planning in which CRAG attempted to engage, the work of the Metropolitan Service District (MSD), created by means of Oregon voter approval in 1970, sought to provide as many concrete regional services as possible. While CRAG did not play a primary role in the creation of the MSD, it did have an interest in the agency and its work.
