PSU Student Presentations

Student Kristie Gladhill shared her research on improved calibration for the Oregon Highway Safety Manual. Goal is to provide new calibration factors to better predict safety.

Student Meead Saberi shared an analysis of effect of rain on measured freeway traffic data. Her research goal was to quantify the measurable effects of rain on traffic flow, speed and incidents. She found minor decrease in traffic volume and speed during rain and a measurable jump in incidents with rainy conditions.

Student Ryan Conrad conducted research to develop methodology for collecting information about intersection crossing times for different categories of bicyclists. The research has implications for signal timing for bicycles.

Student Nikki Wheeler shared her efforts to develop tools for measuring impacts on the freight system. Her research focused on travel time reliability measurement.

Student April Cutter presented on her efforts to develop a collaborative governance model for electric vehicle infrastructure.
