Over the past few years, UPWP project fund obligations have experienced significant difficulties. As a result, some projects were not obligated with the rest of the annual approved UPWP projects. Changes in obligation processes and unobligated fund carry-over processes appear to have resolved the past issues.

During late January, 2019, ODOT and Metro staff met to determine how to resolve the final past unobligated approved UPWP projects enabling them to obligate before July 1, 2019. Previously, these projects were held in abeyance until the UPWP obligation strategy was developed and approved by both Metro and ODOT. The results of the meeting determined older funding not obligated could now move forward to be obligated.


- a. Change Project name from Regional MPO Planning (2019) to be SFY 2020 Portland Metro MPO Planning


