PROPOSED LEGISLATIVE CHANGES TO ORS 268

ACTION - APPROVE PROPOSED LEGISLATIVE PACKAGE

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to metropolitan service districts; creating a new provision; amending ORS 268.030 and 268.310.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

Section 1. ORS 268.030 is amended to read:

268.030. (1) This Chapter is enacted in order to provide a method of making available in metropolitan areas public services not adequately available through previously authorized governmental agencies.

(2) To this end, not more than one district may be established under this Chapter in any metropolitan area.

(3) Subject to the limitations of state law, the district may provide:

(a) Metropolitan aspects of sewerage, solid and liquid waste disposal, control of surface waters, [and] public transportation [~~and~~], public safety communication systems, public library services, and water supply and distribution; and

(b) Metropolitan parks, recreation facilities, and zoos; and

(c) Metropolitan jail and detention facilities;  
and

~~[(b)]~~ (d) [~~Local-aspects-of-these~~] Such public services [~~that-are~~] as may be transferred to the district by agreement between the district and other municipal corporations, cities or counties.

Section 2. ORS 268.310 is amended to read:

268.310. A district may:

(1) Acquire, construct, alter, maintain and operate interceptor, trunk and outfall sewers and pumping stations and facilities for treatment and disposal of sewage as defined in ORS 468.700 and engage in local aspects of sewerage transferred to the district by agreement with other public corporations, cities or counties in accordance with this chapter.

(2) Subject to the requirements of ORS 459.005 to 459.045, 459.065 to 459.105, 459.205 to 459.285, and subsections (1) to (3) of ORS 459.992, dispose, and provide facilities for disposal, of solid and liquid wastes and, by agreement with other public corporations, cities or counties in accordance with this chapter, collect and transport such wastes.

(3) Control the flow, and provide for the drainage, of surface water, by means of dams, dikes, ditches, canals, and similar necessary improvements.

(4) Provide public transportation and terminal facilities for public transportation including local aspects thereof transferred to the district by one or more other public corporations, cities, or counties through agreements in accordance with this chapter.

(5) Acquire, construct, alter, maintain, administer, and operate metropolitan parks, recreational facilities, and zoos.

(6) Provide metropolitan library services including local aspects thereof transferred to the district by one or more other public corporations, cities, or counties, through agreements in accordance with this chapter.

(7) To acquire, construct, alter, maintain, operate, and administer, metropolitan jail and detention facilities.

(8) Provide public safety communication system and the facilities for such system.

(9) To build, construct, acquire, alter, maintain, operate, and administer, water distribution and supply systems and engage in local aspects of water supply and distribution transferred to the district by agreement with other public corporations, cities, or counties, in accordance with this chapter.

Section 3. Section 4 of this act is added to and made a part of ORS Chapter 268.

Section 4. For the purpose of performing the functions set forth in ORS 268.310 (8), the district, when authorized at any properly called election held for such purpose, shall have the power to levy a tax on amounts paid for intrastate telephone service in the district. The tax shall not exceed three percent (3%) of the amount paid for such service. The taxes imposed by this section shall be paid by the person paying for the services.

Section 5. ORS 268.530 is amended to read:

268.530. Elections for the purpose of voting on the question of borrowing funds by issuance and sale of general obligation bonds or revenue bonds or imposing the tax authorized by Section 4 of this act shall be called by the governing body.
