VII. EPA GRANT APPLICATION

THE MSD STAFF HAS PREPARED AN APPLICATION TO THE U.S. ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY (EPA) FOR AN ENERGY RECOVERY IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM. THE EPA HAS REQUESTED THAT GRANT APPLICATIONS FOR FEDERAL ASSISTANCE BE SUBMITTED TO THE EPA SOLID WASTE DIVISION BY MAY 9, 1975. THE GRANT APPLICATION DOCUMENT HAS BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO THE BOARD EARLIER THIS WEEK. THE GRANT REQUEST IS \$127,655 AND WOULD BE EXPENDED DURING THE 1975-76 FISCAL YEAR. TWO MAJOR TASKS ARE PROPOSED, THEY ARE:

- 1. MSD AND LOCAL JURISDICTIONAL AGREEMENTS, ORDINANCES AND REGULATION DEVELOPMENT (\$73,111).
- 2. MARKET RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT FOR ENERGY RECOVERY (\$54,544).

THE STAFF CANNOT ASSESS THE CHANCES OF RECEIVING FUNDING, HOWEVER, THE EPA REGION X ENCOURAGED THE STAFF TO PREPARE THIS APPLICATION.

THE STAFF RECOMMENDS THE MSD BOARD <u>APPROVE</u> SUBMITTAL OF THE APPLICATION FOR ENERGY RECOVERY IMPLEMENTATION GRANT PROGRAM TO THE EPA.
