# 78-991 CONTRACT 77-079 - CITY OF PORTLAND - CETA VI CONTRACT EXTENSION - LANDSCAPE BEAUTIFICATION

THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS PROJECT IS TO FURTHER ENHANCE THE FELINE EXHIBITS AND THE BEAR GROTTOS, MAKING THEM MORE NATURALISTIC AND SOFTENING THE AUSTERE NATURE OF THE EXISTING EXHIBITS. THE PROJECT WILL INVOLVE A LANDSCAPE ARCHITECT TO ASSIST IN SELECTION OF PLANT MATERIALS AND TO PROVIDE BASIC DESIGN AND HORTICULTURAL ADVICE FOR A COST OF \$1,500 AND THREE LABORERS FOR 150 DAYS AT A COST OF \$25,764 INCLUDING FRINGES.

MATERIAL COSTS FOR PLANTS AND SHRUBS, SOIL AMENDMENTS AND IRRIGATION FIXTURES WILL BE APPROXIMATELY \$1,700 AND EQUIPMENT AND VEHICLE RENTAL \$1,000.

# 78-992 CONTRACT 78-130 - WASHINGTON/MULTNOMAH COUNTY CONSORTIUM CETA GRANT - TRAIN TRACK

The objective of this project is to bring the Zoo railroad track and track beds up to safe operating standards. After achieving the safe standards, the tracks and beds will be maintained by regular zoo staff as budgeted. The project is scheduled to last for four months and involves employing three persons to repair rails, switches and ties and to level the bed where necessary. Since the three persons will be using some specialized equipment, they will be paid at a Maintenance I rate of \$5.68 per hour. These employees are on the Consortium payroll and MSD pays the difference between the maximum CETA allowance and the sum paid to Maintenance I employees at the Zoo.

Costs for this project are: Materials and tool rental, \$803.50; wages and fringe benefits for the three Laborers, \$12,323.33.

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# 78-993 CONTRACT 78-131 - WASHINGTON/MULTNOMAH COUNTY CORSORTIUM CETA GRANT - ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANCE

This project's objective is to research and codify the Zoo Division's Administrative Procedures, and to analyze, organize, and index the assorted construction data from 1962 to date. The end result of the project will be to provide documents or organized indexes of the Zoo Division's Administrative Procedures and Physical Growth which will be available for staff use and public inspection. The project will last five months and will employ two persons: A Research/writer paid \$4.79 per hour, and a Research Aid paid \$4.00 per hour. These employees will be on the Consortium's payroll but will be responsible to supervisory personnel at the Zoo.

Costs for this project includes \$547.00 for office material and supplies, and \$9,154.70 in wages.
