THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE WILL PROVIDE A RECOMMENDATION REGARD-ING ENTERING INTO A PHASE II AGREEMENT WITH PUBLISHERS PAPER COMPANY AND/OR PROCEEDING WITH ADDITIONAL WORK TO IMPLEMENT THE RESOURCE RECOVERY PROJECT.

#### 78-1157 ANIMAL QUARANTINE FACILITY CONSTRUCTION BID AWARD

THE METROPOLITAN SERVICE DISTRICT CALLED FOR BIDS FOR CONSTRUCTION OF THE QUARANTINE FACILITY AT THE WASHINGTON PARK ZOO. ONLY TWO BIDS WERE RECEIVED. AFTER CONSIDERABLE REVIEW OF THE QUOTATIONS AND LACK OF RESPONSE, STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT ALL BIDS BE REJECTED AND THAT THE QUARANTINE FACILITY BE REBID BY PACKAGING IT WITH THE ELEPHANT EXPANSION PROJECT WHEN THAT PROJECT GOES TO BID. WE ANTICIPATE A BETTER BIDDING ATMOSPHERE AT THAT TIME AND UNDER THOSE CONDITIONS AND BELIEVE WE CAN GET THE FACILITY BUILT FOR A MORE REASONABLE COST.

# 78-1159 STAFF AUTHORITY FOR WAIVER OF BONDING ON CONTRACT AMOUNTS OF LESS THAN \$10,000

The State Contract Review Board Administrative Rules require that all public improvement contracts for amounts of \$10,000 and over be secured by both bid and performance bonding. However, for contract amounts of under \$10,000, the Administrative Rules allow the agency to waive bidding and performance bonding. In the past the staff has waived this requirement, however, state law requires authorization by the governing body.

THE STAFF RECOMMENDS THAT THE BOARD <u>TRANSFER</u> WAIVER AUTHORITY FOR ALL CONTRACTS UNDER \$10,000 TO THE MSD ADMINISTRATIVE DIVISION DIRECTOR.





FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE ZOO DIVISION AUGUST, 1978

This report is prepared on the basis of information available after the second month of operation in Fiscal Year 1978-79.

#### I. EXPENDITURES/COMMITMENTS

Note that we have defined "commitments" as funds actually paid out and funds obligated (via purchase orders) but not yet paid out. Therefore, the figures below will differ from the "Metropolitan Service District Monthly Budget Report" which reflects only funds actually paid out.

#### II. REVENUES

Resources budgeted for the Zoo Fund total \$4,630,503 in Fiscal Year 1978-79. Funds received to date (July and August) total \$440,907. Funds received to date plus the projected net working capital total \$1,740,807, leaving a balance of \$2,889,696 to be obtained.
