The admin mod completes some minor fund swap updates and primarily adjusts the project MP limits. The mile points needed for the environmental clearance extend slightly beyond the current STIP mile points. There is some signing and striping that will occur beyond the original project extents. The updated MPs are now 3.31 (west end) - 4.83 (east end) and represent a 0.10 mile change to the project limits. This is less than a 0.25 mile change threshold. Environmental clearance cannot be signed until this discrepancy is fixed. There is no change in the total project cost which remains at \$18,501,603.

The updated MPs are now 3.31 (west end) - 4.83 (east end) and represent a 0.10 mile change to the project limits. This is less than a 0.25 mile change. Environmental clearance cannot be signed until this discrepancy is fixed. Thee is no change in the total project cost which remains at \$18,501,603.
